PARISH FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Dear Parishioners,

The Parish Accounts for the Year ended 2017 are now available in the format of a Financial Statement, which are available in the Church Porches, the Parish Office and on the Parish Website. I would like to thank you all for your ongoing generosity which enables the Parish to continue and to offer Pastoral outreach.

The Parish Pastoral Centre was our significant Capital Expenditure (€954,302) and was kept within its budget and thanks to the generosity of many Parishioners we have a shortfall of €300,000, which we hope to clear in due course.

Its important with so much work now done that we do not become complacent as we need to build up our reserves so that when maintenance issues arise we can deal with them promptly.
