After nine years of service to the Parish of Sandyford, Kiltarnan, Glencullen and latterly Balally, Fr Andrew has been asked by the Archbishop to take up the role of Parish Priest of Rathmines.

Fr Andrew has done Trojan work in the years he has served in Sandyford, spearheading the restoration of all our beautiful churches, encouraging lay involvement in parish life, and building the Parish Centre to foster greater fellowship in the Parish.

Fr Andrew has seen many of our young people through their sacramental journey; journeyed with us in happy times, and sad, and has been a diligent pastoral support to the sick who need the blessing of the church.

Fr Andrew will leave us at the end of September.

We wish him every blessing in his new parish and pray that the years ahead will be happy ones for him, his parishioners, and his family.

Fr John Delany (Blackrock) will succeed Fr Andrew as Parish Priest. We look forward to welcoming Fr John in early October.

FAREWELL MASSES

Due to Covid-19 restrictions, a Parish celebration cannot take place as we would have wished.

Instead, Fr. Andrew's farewell in Kiltarnan and Glencullen will take place this Sunday September 20th at the regular Sunday Masses there. In St Mary's, Sandyford, he will say farewell on next Sunday 27th at the 9am and 11am Masses.
