We are delighted to announce that Masses will once again be open to the public from Monday the 10th of May and we look forward to welcoming back our parishioners to attend Mass safely, whilst observing the necessary protocols.

We will once again have a booking system in place to attend

Weekend Masses only.

Parishioners **must register to attend a weekend mass** either through the booking reservation system on the Parish Website or by phone or email to the Parish Office.

We encourage Parishioners who are free on weekdays to consider attending a weekday mass instead of Sunday for the time being, so that we may facilitate attendance for as many as possible.

Numbers strictly limited to 50 in accordance with Government guidelines!!

Please note that our capacity in St Mary's is still 50 and if over 50 people turn up on a weekday they will be asked to attend another day.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping to keep each other safe.
