## New Contactless Payment for Collections in St Mary's

We are pleased to announce the installation of a new Contactless Payment facility for the Diocesan Collections in St Mary's Church.

There are two Tap & Go devices - one at the back left hand side of the Church and one beside the Shrine of Our Lady at the front of the Church. This is a safe, convenient and secure way of donating for those who don't carry cash.

Donations on these units will be divided between the Diocesan First Collection, which supports the Priests of the Parish and the Share Collection, which helps to fund Diocesan, Administration, Pastoral Workers and the upkeep of Church Properties.

Contributions to the Collections can also continue to be made in the envelopes provided in the Church Porches.

The payment machine at St Therese's Shrine will remain in place and contributions to this go directly to the Parish.

We are very grateful for your ongoing generosity in supporting the Diocesan Collections and Parish funds.
