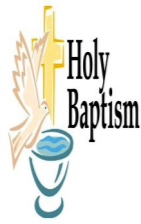

The Vigil Mass in St Mary's is congregational singing led by various cantors according to a rota. Once a month our Folk Group take the music for this mass when contemporary music is played for the Saturday Liturgy. The Sunday 9am Mass in St Mary's is congregational singing led by a cantor and on occasion is a quiet mass with Organ Music to accompany

The Sunday 11am Mass in St Mary's is the **Solemn Mass** with the Sandyford Parish Choir – the Choir sing each week of the year (excluding July & August) and especially at the solemn days leading up to Easter. The choir is led by Sr Finbarr.

The Sunday 10am Mass in St Patrick's, Glencullen is led by the "Glencullen Church Choir" who practise weekly on Monday nights. The choir is led by Renee Roe.

The Sunday 12 Noon Mass in Our Lady of the Wayside, Kiltarnan has music on a monthly basis from our popular Folk Group Trio - according to a rota – The Blue Church is currently looking for an organist to play hymns at the 12 Mass on alternate Sundays where there is no music.
