### Update on temporary Suspension of Sandyford Lotto

As many of you will be aware, we are currently awaiting renewal of the annual licence for the Sandyford Parish Lotto, before we can resume running the weekly draws. We understand from our solicitor, that the application for the renewal of the Lottery Licence will be in the courts this week, however we have been advised that the lottery cannot be run for a period of 60 days after the granting of such a licence. Therefore, we anticipate the lottery being up and running by the end of October.

We wish to reassure you that the current entries will be rolled over and honoured when the Draw resumes.

We would like to apologise for any inconvenience and we will notify you as soon as we are able to continue with this very vital source of fundraising for the Parish.
