The Christmas Dues envelopes continue to be available at the Church doors. The Christmas Dues together with the First Collection provides the monthly remuneration of all Dublin diocesan priests.

Offerings to the Christmas Dues can be included in the **total of annual donations** from parishioners for **Tax Reclaim** purposes. If the total donations are in excess of €250 and subject to the parishioner's agreement, the Parish can then process a Tax Claim on that donation.
