YEAR OF ST FRANCIS

Pope Leo has declared 2026 a special holy year commemorating the 800th Anniversary of the Passing of the great Saint Francis of Assisi. From now until Jan. 10 of next year, the faithful can obtain a special grace under the usual conditions — sacramental Confession, Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the pope — by making a pilgrimage to any Franciscan church or place of worship dedicated to St. Francis anywhere in the world. The Parish would recommend -that we all read a book on the life of St Francis — and to pray the St Francis Prayer regularly.
